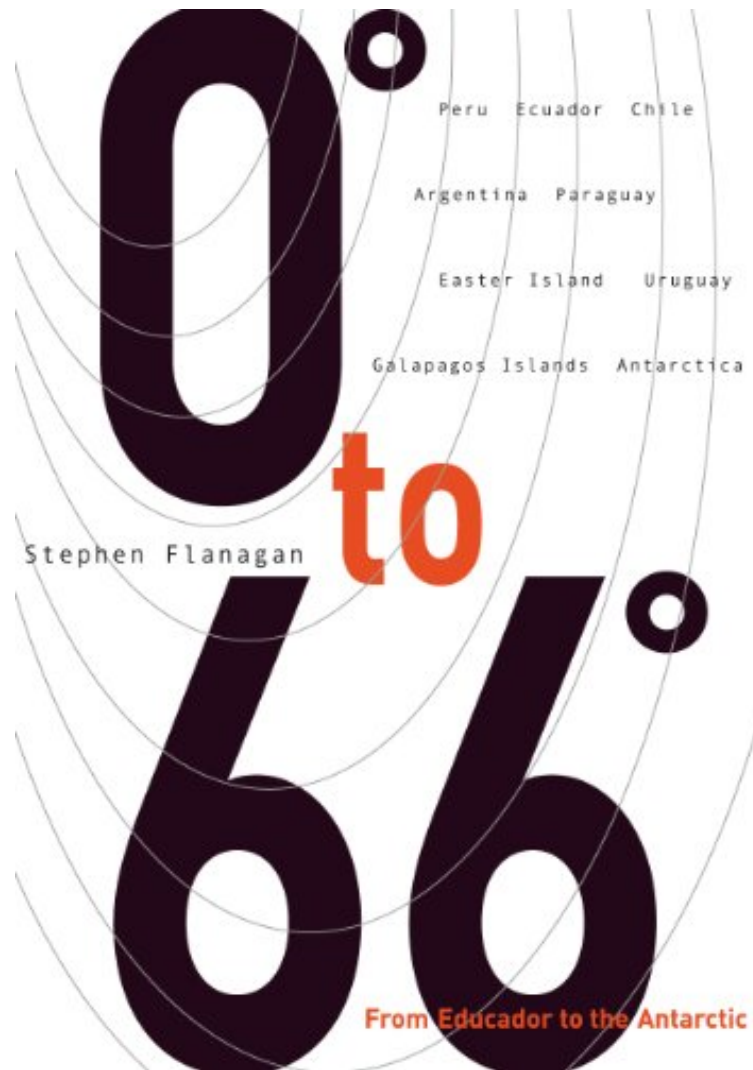

From tourist staples like the Machu Pichu through to the Galapagos Islands, Patagonia down to the Easter Islands and the Antarctic, Stephen ticks off quite a few of my would-love-to-sees in South America, while seasoning everything with wry
