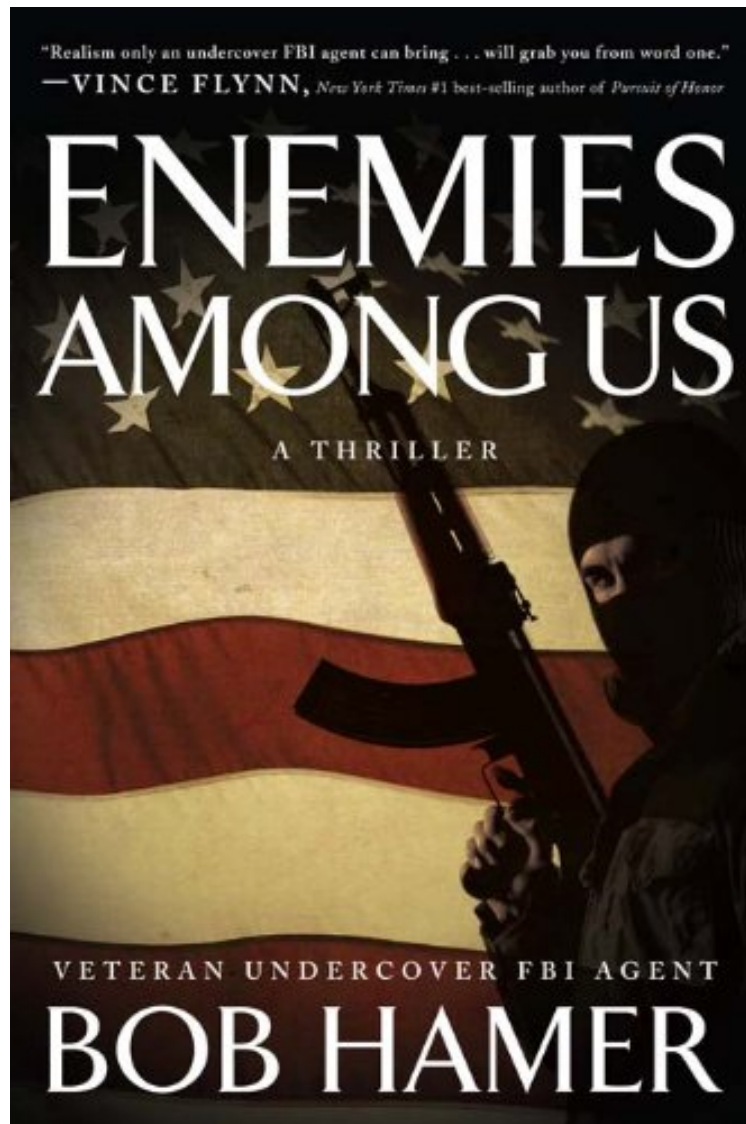

I admit, the price combined with the fact that my interest was caught by the plot description were the main reasons to download the item to my Kindle anyway. In the end I'm glad I did because Hamer's writing style and his experience (retired FBI) made for a suspenseful and interesting read.Spoiler!-

"Someday you'll have to tell me what 'chatter' is." [...] "When I find out, I'll let you know. I worked there two years and still don't know exactly what they mean..." - The FBI doesn't reimburse towed undercover cars. Matt is an FBI agent working undercover at a clinic, following up on a lead to expose possible terrorist activity. His wife Caitlin is a teacher. Some readers might be slightly put off by her strong faith. *Enemies Among Us* constitutes as Christian fiction. However, it didn't bother me. I especially liked that Hamer implemented a distinction between terrorists and Muslims in his storyline. Also, he made clear that success doesn't always come easily. Most of the time it's hard work with a splash of luck that pays off. He didn't describe Matt as a never failing superhero, which in turn made the plot that much more plausible. "...poor job of selling his presence in the room." Reading *Enemies Among Us* was an exciting, pulse-pounding ride. 4.5 stars only because even though the christian message didn't bother me throughout most of the book, the beginning of the epilogue was a little too cheesy for my taste.
