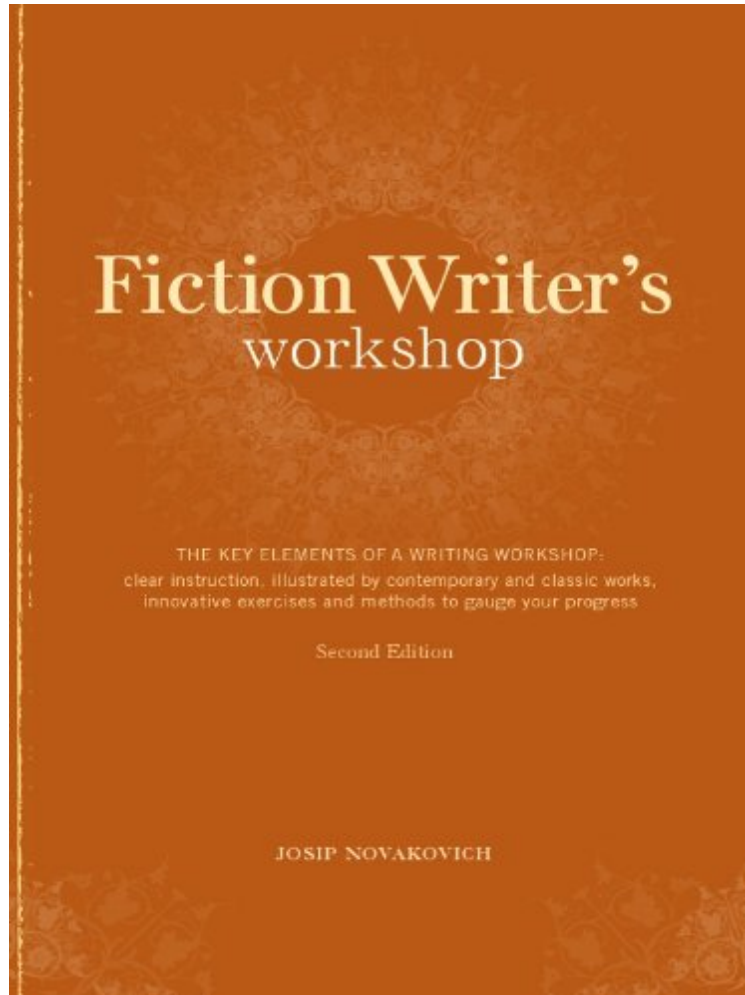

Auerdem stehen nach jeder Aufgabe noch Fragen die dazu anregen sollen die eigene Arbeit nochmals kritisch zu betrachten und eventuell sogar

dazu die Aufgabe nochmals neu zu versuchen um den maximalen Lerneffekt zu erreichen. Im Anhang finden sich dann noch acht Kurzgeschichten, von denen jede im Anschluss durch Kommentare erlutert und mit einer Anregung zu einem Schreibexperiment versehen ist. Den Schreibstil des Autors empfinde ich als sehr angenehm und niemals als "von-oben-herab" wie es leider bei einigen anderen Autoren hin und wieder vorkommt. Ich blttere deshalb auch des fteren wieder durch bereits gelesene Kapitel um mir deren Inhalt wieder aufzufrischen.
