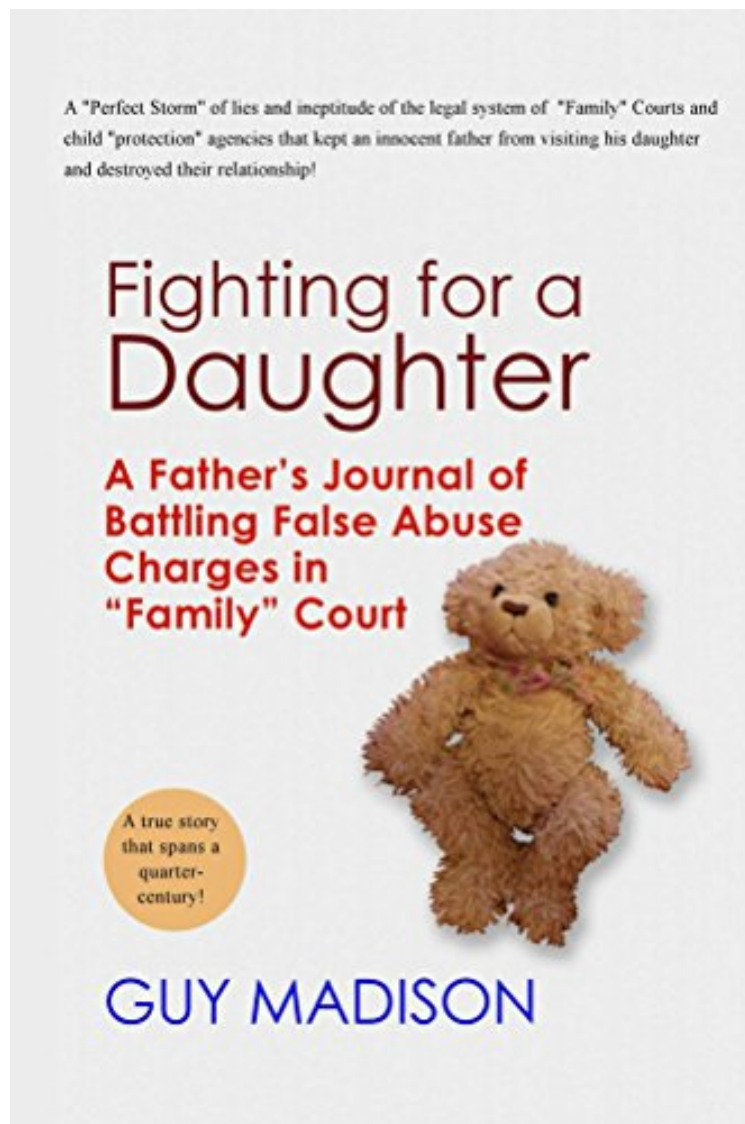

Much more than emotional confessionVon Helpful AdviceWith Fighting for a Daughter, the author Guy Madison takes reader to a journey into the past, back to the worst period in his life when because of false abuse charges that came from his ex-wife and members of her family, Madison was not in position to be with his daughter for a long period of time.Although it is difficult to say how many cases similar to his exist out there, even knowing that one man suffered so much injustice makes this book a work that is certainly worth reading in order to prevent any future similar cases.Madisons memoir is strong and full of emotions as author tells the story about his ex-wife that because of fear that he will get the custody lied whatever she was able in order to make sure he would be no longer a threat to her plans. Unfortunately, nor the organizations did not help - Family Court and Child Welfare - but justice even though it was slow at the end prevailed and many years later the author got a chance to explain his daughter what actually happened.Taking into consideration that the time period was long until the truth came to light, no one could turn back the time. So it took time and effort to make daughter father relationship better, but today they two are extremely close, and the author's granddaughter and his son-in-law together with his daughter are also integral parts of happy family.As author told, his case is not unique, but is certainly one of the worst examples of parental alienation. Therefore, Guy Madison with his story is trying to reach as many people as possible, including those that can improve how false allegations are handled, especially during the divorce cases, in same time keeping children safe from real abusers.Rightly the author concludes that Child Welfare can be distracted from working on real abuse cases while losing time on false ones. Hence his book is not just a story about authors own painful case, but also offers particular solutions to improve the system, in order to avoid similar situation for the benefit of children, and their parents as well.As conclusion it must be said that Guy Madisons book in addition to being an emotional confession of one parent whose child was unjustly taken away while he was wrongly accused, also gives hope that injustice in the end will be always corrected while reading of this book and similar can certainly be of additional help.I was given a copy of this book by the author for the purpose of unbiased review, while all the presented information is based on my impressions.
