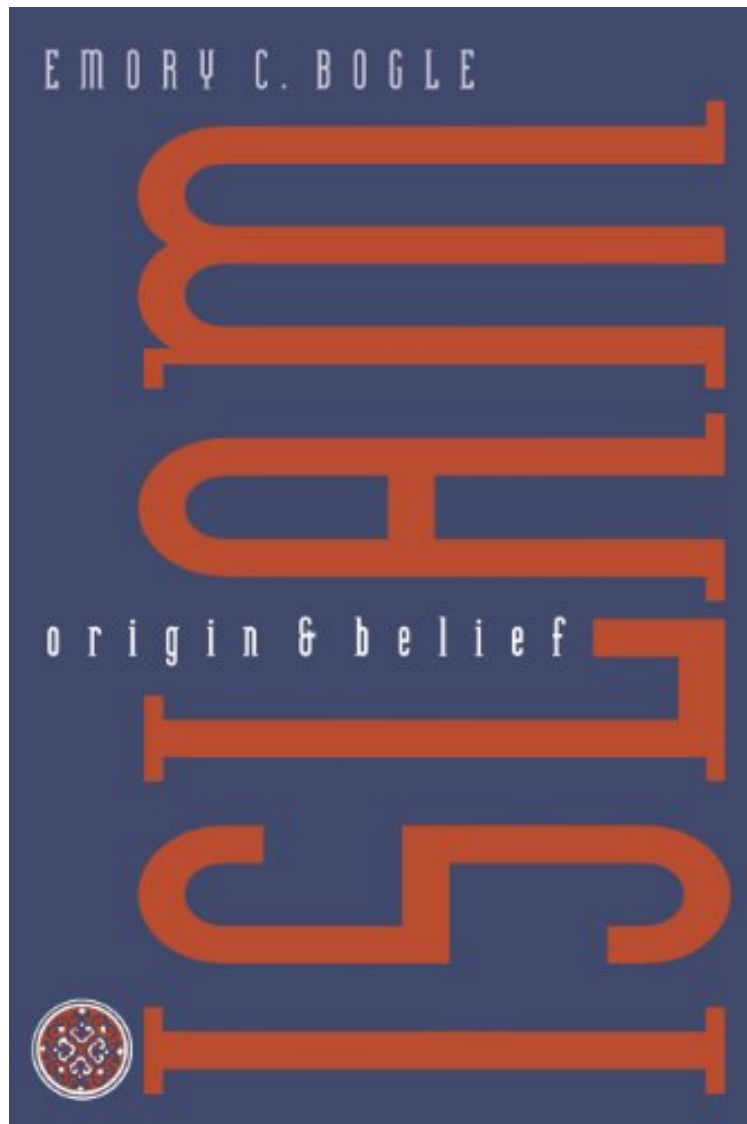

This book was one of the required texts, but it is far from a textbook. Before taking this course, I knew virtually nothing regarding the Middle East, or Islam. Dr. Bogle presents a very detailed, but not drawn out, account of the conditions that led to the rise of Islam, as well as how it took over the Middle East within a very short period of time. Clarity and precise writing are the words I would use to describe this book.
