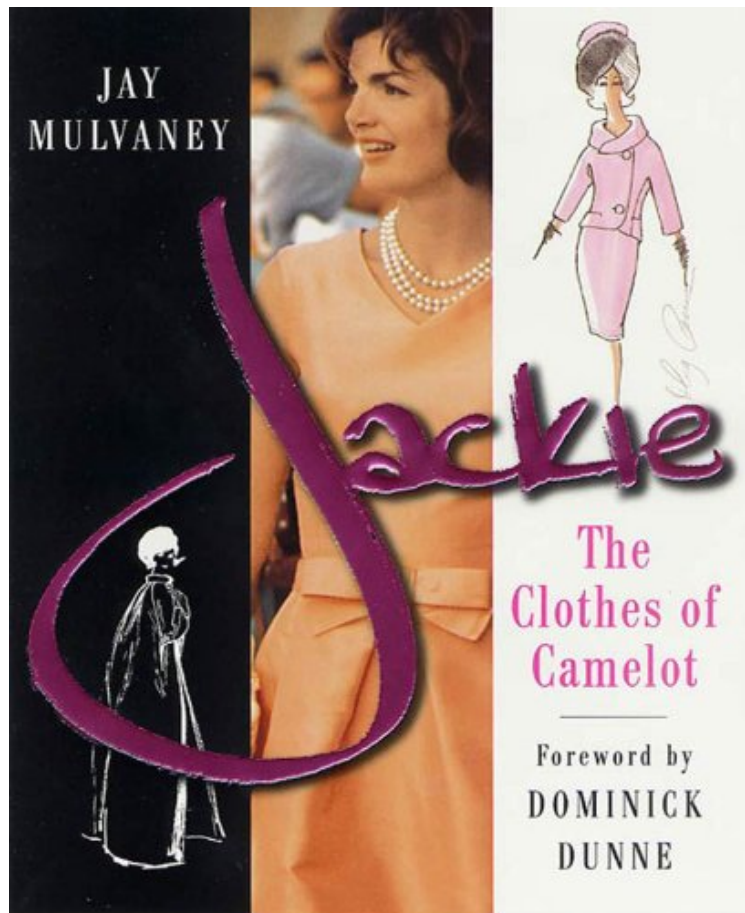

This book also contains a great number of wonderful pictures in color and b/w of Jackies clothes. The "Camelot" years in the White House take most of the place. But - unlike Cassini - Dunne also shows dresses by other designers Jackie wore - and she did! He also gives a chapter to Jackies clothes before the White House and another chapter to her clothes after the White House. The book even contains a collection of pictures with "mishaps" that show, that even a Fashion Icon sometimes made faults. And in an outlook the author shows "Jackie-Fashion-Dolls" which show her Influence in Fashion History.Describing the White House Years, the dresses are not shown in chronological order but in groups like "State Event Gowns", "Foreign Travel", "Day Clothes", "Private Clothes" (which also shows many pictures of the private rooms of the Kennedys in the White House).It is a pity the book does contain only very few sketches of the original
