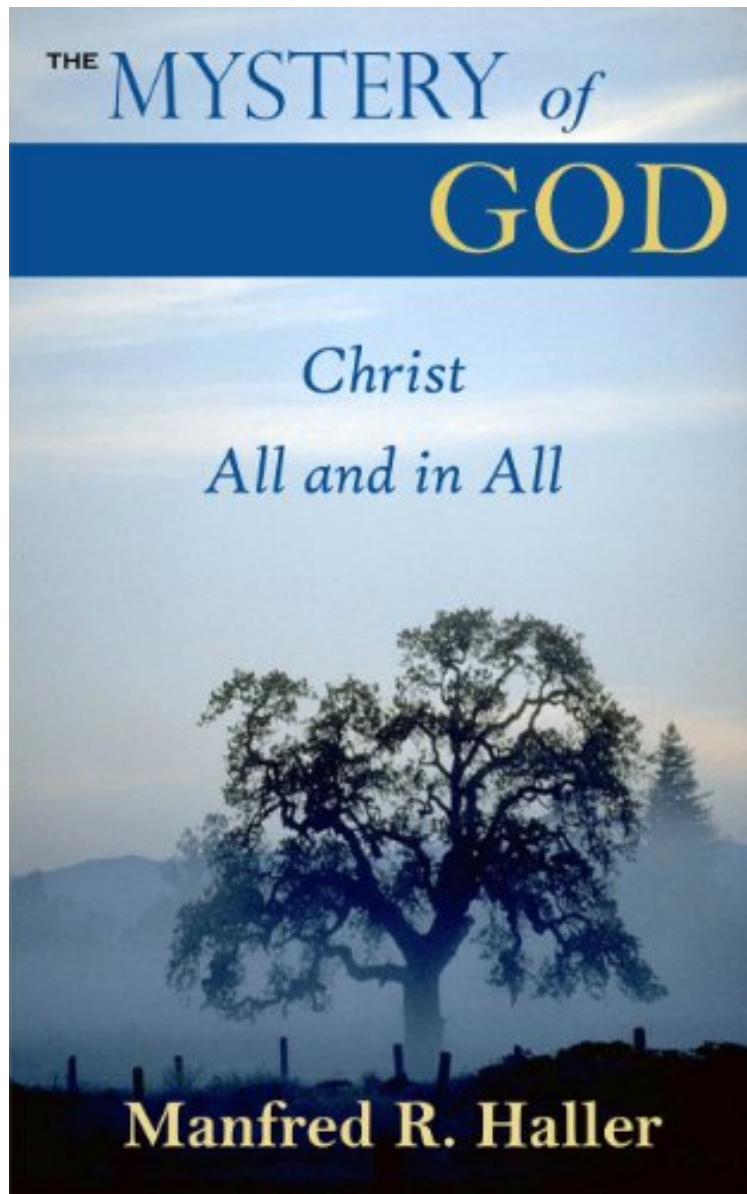

they think about something. This book is on my short list. Originally published under the Title, Christ--The Mystery of God: Re-discovering New Testament Church Life, it is a call to try and grasp what empassions God Himself. The author briefly surveys the myriad forms of Christian belief and industry, and asks, "is God really interested in any of this?" Manfred Haller suggests that God is fundamentally interested in His Son, and only what pertains to Him. He takes the Christian reader beyond sin and salvation and reminds us that God had an agenda even before Adam, pointing to the eternal purpose stated by Apostle Paul: The summing up of all things in Christ. By reading many biblical examples in this context, it will dawn on most readers how much their understanding of scripture had been pre-digested for them, parochial or shallow. My reaction at one point was to lay the book down and murmur, "if this is what God is after--how can we ever accomplish it? Our best churches are light years away!" The consequence for most readers will be a critical look at the assumptions and conduct of one's personal and Church life.
