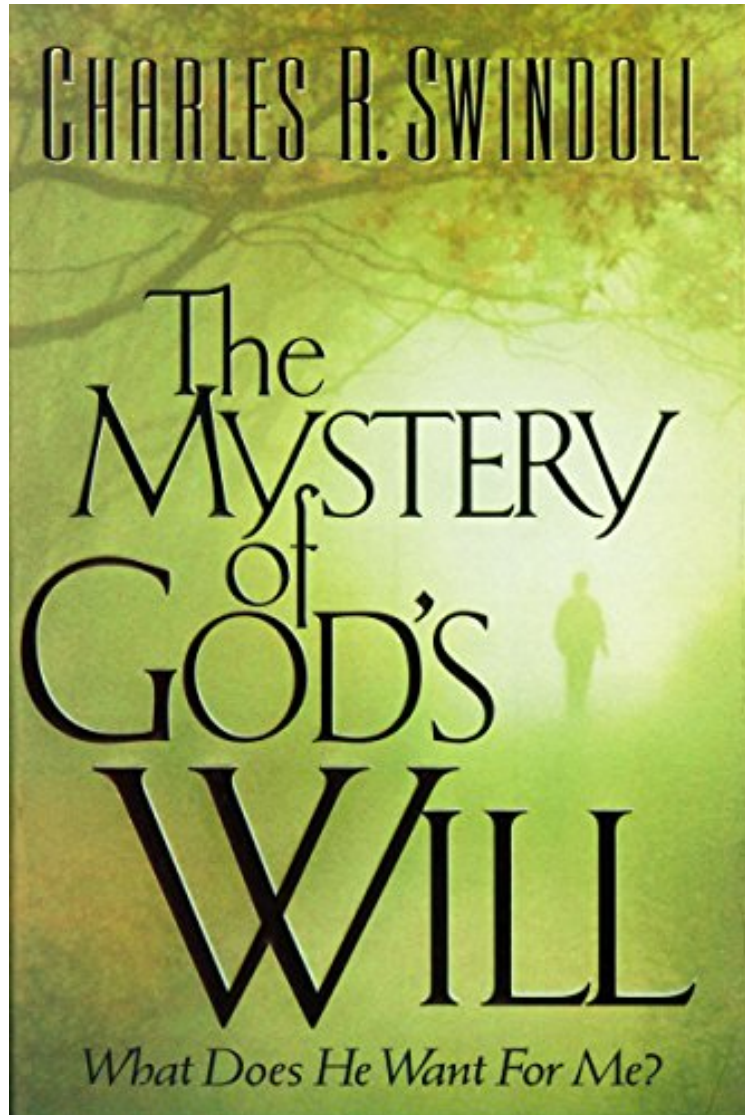

However, this volume, despite its instruction to think theologically, falls into a man-centered--me-centered--approach to God's will, exhibiting greater concern about "God's will for my life" than about God's will for God Himself, and ignoring crucial biblical portions regarding God's will in relation to God's

purpose and heart's desire. Revelation 4:11 and Ephesians 1, for example, are not given due consideration.
