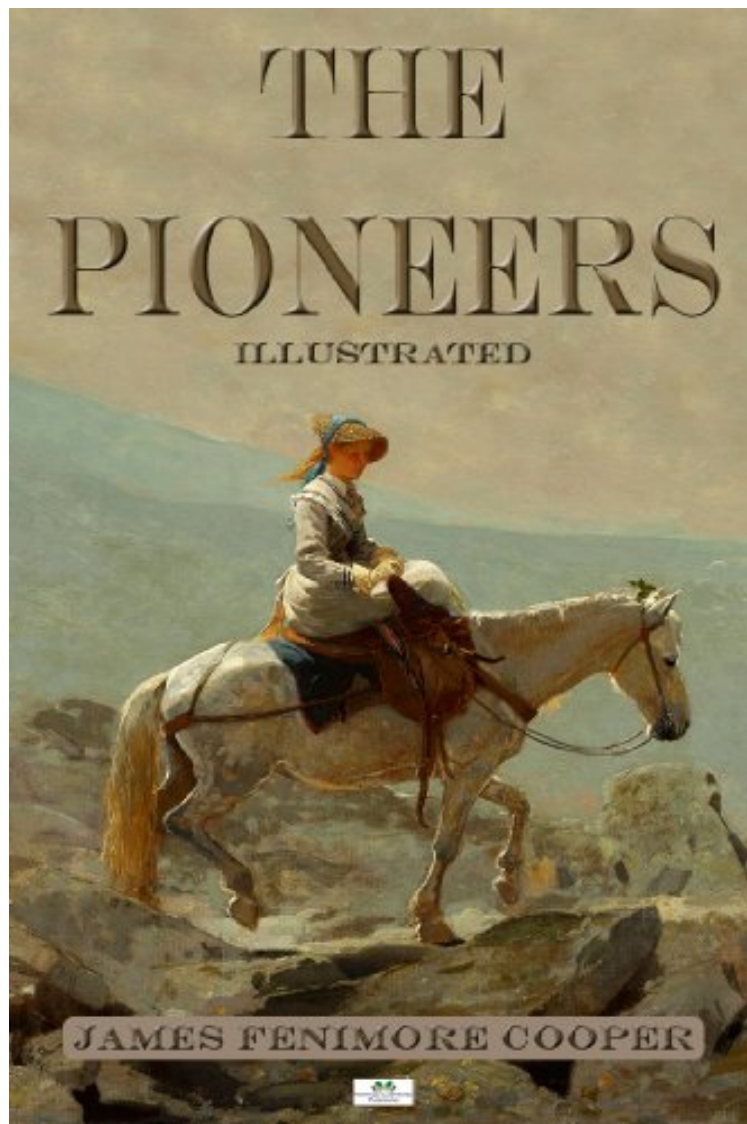

Sie haben Adalbert Stifter beeinflusst, der manches bei Cooper geklaut hat. Und sie waren natürlich die Basis für Karl Mays erzählerisches Werk.
