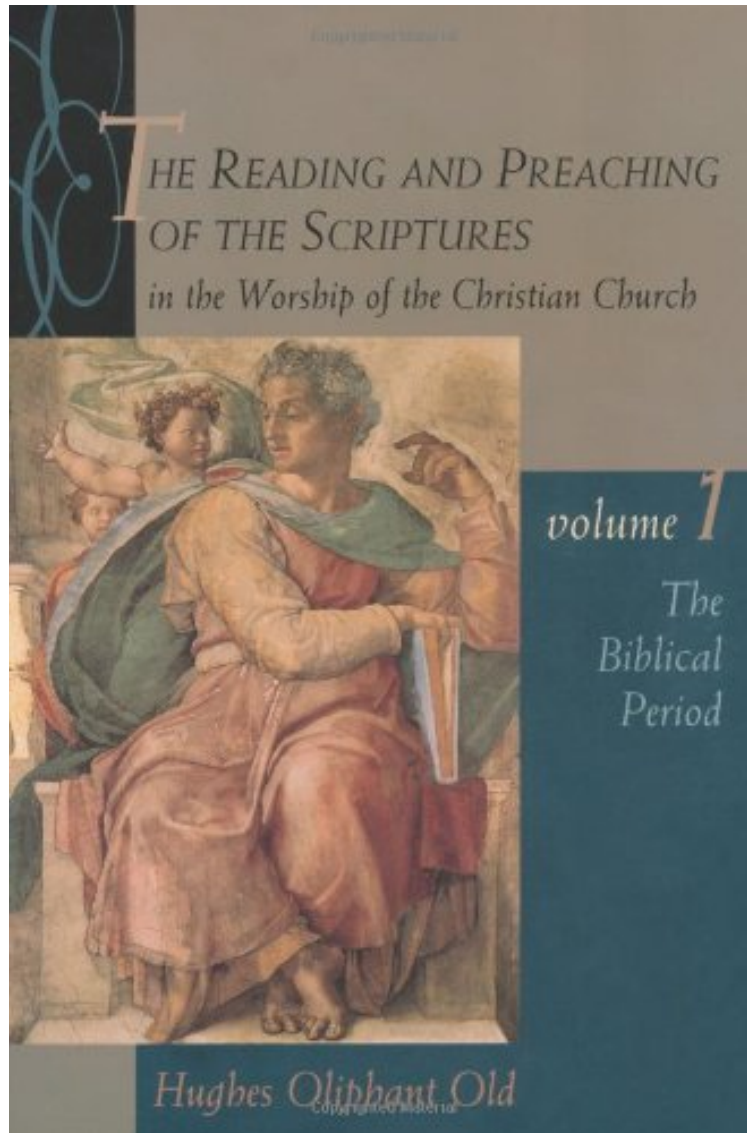

The book is as much a history of the use of the bible in church as it is a history of preaching. His methodology is classic. He takes the reader from Mt. Sinai through the prophets into the earliest days of the Christian Church. He traces the various kinds of preaching through the patristic era in both East and West. These two volumes should be mandatory reading in every seminary. As an Eastern Orthodox Priest, I found the first two volumes of this series extremely helpful and informative.

KurzbeschreibungThe Reading and Preaching of the Scriptures in the Worship of the Christian Church is a multivolume study by Hughes Oliphant Old that canvasses the history of preaching from the words of Moses at Mount Sinai through modern times. In Volume 1, The Biblical Period, Old begins his survey by discussing the roots of the Christian ministry of the Word in the worship of Israel. He then examines the preaching of Christ and the Apostles. Finally, Old looks at the development and practice of Christian preaching in the second and third centuries, concluding with the ministry of Origen.
